Summary of Events

Burglary Habitation

12900 Windfern Rd – Complainant reported during the night time hours, unknown suspect(s) broke a window to her apartment to gain entry, stole items and fled the scene undetected. Case open pending further investigation.

Theft Other

9900 FM 1960 Rd W. – Complainant reported that unknown suspect(s) stole the front license plate off their vehicle during an unknown time period.

9900 FM 1960 Rd W. – Complainant reported an unknown suspect took items from them. No leads at this time.

12900 Windfern Rd – Complainant reported that an unknown suspect stole their catalytic converter from their vehicle during the night time hours. Case open pending further investigation.

10900 FM 1960 Rd W. - Deputies were dispatched to location in reference to a shoplifter call at the Walgreens Store. Upon arrival, contact was made with the store manager who stated a known male entered the store, went behind the counter and stole six packages of cigarettes and fled the location. The male has previously been given a criminal trespass from location for prior thefts. The Harris County District Attorney's office was contacted and relayed the facts of the case and charges of criminal trespass were filed on the suspect and a theft citation will also be issued upon arrest. Case open pending arrest.

10900 FM 1960 Rd W. – Complainant stated an unknown person entered the Walgreens Shopping store, took items from within the store at the location and fled without paying. No leads at this time. No suspect information at this time.

Criminal Mischief

9900 FM 1960 Rd W. – Unknown juvenile suspect broke a window to a complainant's apartment and fled the scene upon being startled by a neighbor. Case open pending further investigation.

10700 W FM 1960 – Complainant reported that an unknown suspect attempted to steal his catalytic converter; however upon being noticed they fled the scene. Case open pending further investigation.

Family Disturbance

13000 Windfern Rd. - Deputies responded to location in reference to a physical disturbance among family members. Upon arrival, and thorough investigation, charges were filed on a male for family assault. Report completed and charges filed.

13000 Windfern Rd – Deputies responded to location in reference to a physical disturbance among family members. Upon arrival, and thorough investigation, a report was completed and no charges were filed.

9900 FM 1960 Rd W. – Deputies responded to location in reference to a family assault call. Upon arrival, investigation revealed that a physical disturbance among a boyfriend and girlfriend was reported. The Harris County District Attorney's office was contacted and family assault charges were filed. Case cleared with charges filed.

9900 FM 1960 Rd W. – Deputies responded to location in reference to a physical disturbance among family members. Upon arrival, and thorough investigation, a report was completed and no charges were filed.

13000 Windfern Rd – Deputies responded to location in reference to a family disturbance. Upon arrival, a loud verbal disturbance was observed by deputies and upon contact with the persons inside the home, a gun was observed in plain view. While deputies attempted to secure the gun for safety, a suspect began to physical interfere with deputies and while attempting to detain the male, he began to resist detention. Upon further investigation, it was found that no assault took place, and the male was charges with interfering with duties of a public servant as he resisted detention. Case closed.

Assault

10500 FM 1960 Rd W. - Complainant reported while she was on location to get eyelashes put on, a verbal disturbance began over her not wearing a mask and then reported she was assaulted during her lash service. Charges were declined in the matter and report completed.

Other Calls

9900 Fm 1960 Rd. W. - Welfare Check - Deputies were dispatched to location in reference to a welfare check. Upon arrival, they found a complaint who was having a mental crises. Deputies transported the subject to a local mental health facility for treatment.

9900 FM 1960 Rd. W. - Credit Card Fraud - Complainant reported that known suspect opened a line of credit without their consent. Case open pending further investigation.

10900 FM 1960 - Public Intoxication - While on patrol, deputies observed a suspicious person passed out on the sidewalk. Upon contact with the male, he was observed to be homeless and heavily intoxicated. The male was transported to a nearby hospital as a precaution, due to his severe intoxicated status. Report completed.

9900 FM 1960 RD W. - FSGI Accident - Complainant reported during the overnight hours, an unknown suspect struck his truck that was parked in the apartment complex parking lot on location. No leads at this time. Report completed.
