Criminal Mischief:

10900 FM 1960 Road W – Deputy issued citations to violator for improper transportation signs on the right of way. All citations were found.

13000 Windfern Rd- Complainant reported that her identity documents were stolen from her

10900 FM 1960 Road W- Complainant reported a a black hand gun being pointed at him by another driver. Compliant was able to get the vehicle make, model, and description of the driver before being told to stop following the vehicle. The case is still open for further investigation
