Safety Tips from Constables

We received the following safety tips from local constables. The constables also asked that we remind you that they are strictly enforcing the laws with regards to speeding, state inspection, vehicle registration, Driver's License Registration, wearing seat belts, etc.

- Vacation Tips:
 - Contact constable's office to arrange for a constable vacation watch. They will drive by your home once a day while you are on vacation.
 - Tell your neighbors how long you will be gone and how they can contact you if needed. Also, take your neighbors phone numbers with you. Consider giving your keys to a friend so they can access your home if needed.
 - Stop your US Mail Service. Go to www.usps.com to arrange this.
 - Stop newspaper delivery

- Put timers on lights inside the house.
- Keep garage doors closed when you are not outside.
- · Keep back gate locked.
- Have a strong neighborhood watch program.
- Keep the shrubs trimmed around you house to discourage anyone hiding behind the shrubs.
- Don't leave "stuff" in front of your house that might interest vandals.

If you see someone or something suspicious, see someone vandalizing property, contact the constables immediately. Keep in mind security cameras are in the playground/pool area. If you witness any inappropriate activity report it. A date and time frame is all that is needed to look for the perpetrator(s).

Prepare ahead.

Disaster Plan

Establish escape routes and places to meet. Post emergency numbers by your phone.

Choose an out-of-state family member as a point of contact in an emergency.

Stock up on non-perishable supplies and put together a Disaster supply Kit.

Disaster Supply Kit

Water, Food, Clothing First aid Kit Cash, Keys Fueled Vehicles Flashlights and batteries Prescription drugs Important documents



Q: Can I mow my yard or have a lawn service mow my yard at 7:00 am? A: Neither Harris County nor our deed restrictions state specific times, but we encourage everyone to be considerate of their neighbors.
Q: Do I have to fill out an ACC application prior to work being done on my home? A: Yes, an ACC application MUST be filled out before any exterior work (ie: painting, siding, remodeling, etc.) can be done.
