

How To Get Pool Tags BEFORE Pool Opens – May 28, 2022

1. Only those homeowners and residents of HBTM whose property maintenance fees have been paid will be given pool tags.
2. Complete and sign the “Pool Tag Registration Form”. (Attached)
3. Covid-19 participation waivers will be required. The waiver you signed in 2020 or 2021 is still in-effect and you will NOT need to sign a new waiver.
4. **New signed waivers needed for:**
 - a. any family member who was not covered by the 2020 or 2021 waiver
 - b. any family member who turns 18 after June 1, 2022 as they are now an adult and must sign their own waiver
 - c. any new homeowners/residents of HBTM
 - d. Appropriate waiver forms are available in the Red Realtor box
5. Put your completed “Pool Tag Registration Form” (and signed waivers required as per Item 4 above) in the black metal box at the pool entrance by **MAY 18, 2022**. Any forms received after this date will be processed as per “How To Get Pool Tags AFTER Pool Opens”, below.
6. Pool tag distribution – You can pick-up your tags on Saturday, May 21 from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and Wednesday, May 25 from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. After these dates/times you will be charged a handling fee.
 - a. Wearing a face mask is required to pick-up your tags and we ask that you continue to socially distance.
 - b. Bring last year’s pool tags with you when you pick-up your new tags. Also, bring any MINOR (dark green) tags as you will get new ones. There is a \$2.00 charge for any lost tags.
 - c. You must be 18 years of age to pick-up pool tags.

How To Get Pool Tags AFTER Pool Opens

1. Only those homeowners and residents of HBTM whose property maintenance fees have been paid will be given pool tags.
2. Pick-up a “Pool Tag Registration Form” (and new waiver if needed – see Item 4 above) from the realtor box (with red trim) at the pool entrance. Complete and sign the forms
3. Put the completed “Pool Tag Registration Form” and completed waiver, if needed, in the black metal box at the pool entrance. Forms will be picked-up approximately once a week.
4. You will be texted/called to meet at pool to get your pool tags. It may take up to ten (10) business days to process your request for pool tags.
 - a. A day and time to get pool tags will be agreed to with you. If you miss this appointment, it is your responsibility to call or text the Pool Committee to reschedule.
 - b. Bring last year’s pool tags and any MINOR (dark green) tags with you when you pick-up your new tags. Bring \$5.00 per requested pool tag. Bring ONLY correct dollars. No change can be made; no checks or credit cards can be accepted.
 - c. Wear a face mask. Social distancing will be enforced.
 - d. You must be 18 years of age to pick-up pool tags.

If You Move Into HBTM AFTER Pool Opens

- The stated requirements above in “How to get pool tags AFTER pool opens” apply.
- When we meet to give you your tags, you will need to bring objective evidence (closing documents, rental contract, etc.) that you moved into HBTM AFTER date the pool opens. In that case, you will not need to pay the \$5.00 per requested tag.
- You must be 18 years of age to pick-up pool tags.

If You Lose Your Pool Tags

- See “How To Get Pool Tags AFTER Pool Opens” above. All stated requirements apply.
